Paly Video Productions presents: a curated selection of works from the Fall 2013-Spring 2014 school year, showcasing work from both beginning and advanced video production students.

Beginning video films include silent movies showcasing the concerns of everyday students, horror/German expressionist-inspired tales of 'individuals and difference' and films that speculate upon future uses of technology and how it might impact students--for better or for worse.

Advanced student films include visual adaptations of poetry, visualized works of creative nonfiction (real stories with imagined narratives) and speculate upon or celebrate uses of technology in education--for better or more sinister purposes.

Film Club and teacher Brett Griffith curated and selected work on the basis of creativity, quality and diversity with respect to filmmaker, perspective and overall tone. The works aim to function as a whole to celebrate the collective sound and vision of Paly filmmakers.

Works will be judged by a panel consisting of editors, academics, and business professionals from the entertainment industry. Each class (beginning and advanced respectively) will receive (2) critics choice awards that recognize production value, use of formal techniques and height of concept/complexity of subject matter.
